COFFIN FOUND AT NEW SCHOOL

A grim discovery was made Wed. by a bulldozer operater when a grave was uncovered at the new \$100.000 junior high school. The site was apparently an old graveyard. John Parker of 3436 Grandview Highway was levelling the grounds at 4:30 p.m. when the blade of his bulldozer cut into a coffin. The skeleton remains were taken to Bowell and Sons Chapel.

John Furness, former works superintentant recalled today that a graveyard was well est. when he came here in 1888. It contained the graves of British settlers and Royal Engineers. It became a chinese cemetary in 1909 and was abandoned some 20 years ago when the chinese were sent back to their homeland.
