


COVID-19

CURRENT TRENDS

- Recent provincial orders have not changed our current protocols
- 549 active COVID-19 exposures in schools (16 NWS)
- 81% in 14 school districts
- 28 school districts have had o exposures
- Risk in school community in 4x lower than community at large
- In-school transmissions (12) are predominantly as a result of breakdown in protocols
- Half of our schools and programs have had o exposures and we have not sent any self—isolation notices




