Re: Upcoming Provincial Graduation Assessments

As part of the British Columbia graduation requirements, students must complete the following provincial assessments:

- 1. Graduation Literacy Assessment 10 (GLA 10)
- 2. Graduation Numeracy Assessment 10 (GNA 10)
- 3. Graduation Literacy Assessment 12 (GLA 12)
- 4. Évaluation de littératie de la 12e année Français langue seconde immersion *(for French Immersion students only)*

This year, New Westminster Secondary School will offer two sessions for these assessments:

- January 2026 Session
 - Numeracy 10, Literacy 10, and Literacy 12: January 14, 15, and 16
 - French Immersion:
 - Written: January 13 (Morning)
 - Oral: January 22 (Morning)
- June 2026 Session (for students who missed the January session)
 - Numeracy 10, Literacy 10, and Literacy 12: June 8 and 9
 - o French Immersion:
 - Written: June 8 (Afternoon)
 - Oral: June 9 (Morning)

Please note that these dates fall within our "Semester Incomplete Days."

Évaluation de littératie de la 12e année is for our French Immersion students only. There is a written and an oral component to this assessment. The written component is scheduled for **January 13th morning**, and the oral component is scheduled for **January 22nd morning**. Furthermore, we have scheduled the written component for **June 8th afternoon and June 9th morning** for the oral component.

Registration:
