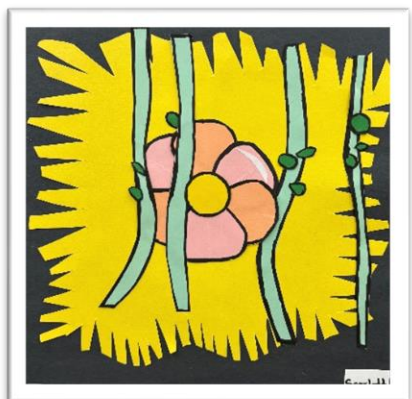
Library Open Mondays for Families 3:00 – 3:30
