#### REGISTRATION

#### KEY DATES FOR THE 2025-26 SCHOOL YEAR

We are always excited to welcome new families to the District. Here are the things you need to know to ensure your student is enrolled with the best placement to support their needs.

#### Key dates for regular registration:

	In-catchment applications	Transfer requests & Out-of-district applications
Regular registration opens	November 4, 2024	February 3, 2025
Regular registration closes	January 31, 2025	February 28, 2025
Placement offers	March 28, 2025	June 13, 2025

Please note: our District is facing significant capacity challenges, due to growing enrollment. Decisions about the 2025–26 school year are based on enrollment demands identified within the regular registration window. Enrolment applications received outside of this window will be placed within the district but may not be possible at the catchment or preferred school requested, as some schools may be deemed as being at full capacity at certain grades, or in some limited cases, for the full school. All placements follow the rules outlined in <u>Administrative Procedure 300</u>.

Our Central Registration team works out of the Welcome Centre (south side of New Westminster Secondary School, via the external entrance). 


