Regional Water Meter Upgrades – Sherbrooke Location

Building new infrastructure to ensure the continued delivery of high-quality drinking water for the region's growing population

Project Overview

Metro Vancouver will be installing a new flow meter with underground chamber to a Metro Vancouver water main at Sherbrooke Street between Richmond Street and Blair Avenue in the City of New Westminster. A flow meter is a device that measures the flow rate of water inside the pipe and will help manage the increasing water demand in our growing region and improve accuracy in measuring water use. Construction is estimated to begin in late 2025 and last for approximately six months.

Project Activities

- Preparing the work area, delivering equipment, and installing temporary construction fencing and signage to ensure the safety of construction crews and road users
- Excavating a pit to expose the existing water main on Sherbrooke Street between Blair Avenue and Richmond Street
- Excavating an area on Sherbrooke Street in front of Sapperton Park, between Buchanan Avenue and Knox Street to access existing infrastructure, and isolate the watermain
- Constructing a new underground chamber to hold a flow meter and electrical equipment
- Connecting the new meter to the existing electrical kiosk
- Backfilling and restoring the work area



Traffic, Access, and Noise

Metro Vancouver is committed to minimizing construction impacts whenever possible; however, we recognize this construction may impact you and the community. We anticipate the following impacts:

- **Traffic:** Full road closure on Sherbrooke Street between Richmond Street and Blair Avenue; emergency vehicle and driveway access will be maintained
- **Sidewalk:** Temporary closure of north sidewalk on Sherbrooke Street between Richmond Street and Blair Avenue
- **Traffic:** Partial closure on Sherbrooke Street in front of Sapperton Park, between Buchanan Avenue and Knox Street, for approximately 6 weeks
- **Parking:** Temporary restricted parking around work areas
- **Noise:** There will be moderate noise from construction vehicles and equipment in the area; crews will attempt to reduce noise impacts to nearby residents wherever possible

Drivers, cyclists, and Pedestrians are asked to follow direction of signage and traffic control personnel

Timeline and Hours of Work

- **Construction:** Late 2025 to summer 2026
- **Work hours:** Typical work hours will be Monday to Saturday, 7:00 am to 5:00 pm.

This timeline is subject to change, and there may be times when construction crews will need to work longer hours to complete certain tasks safely and efficiently. All work will comply with the City of New Westminster bylaws and granted bylaw variances.

About our Water System

Metro Vancouver provides high-quality drinking water to 3 million residents in the region through a system of water supply areas, dams, treatment facilities, reservoirs, pump stations, and water mains. Upgrades are continuously being made to the water system to maintain the quality and reliability of our drinking water.

Metro Vancouver delivers water to member jurisdictions who then distribute the water to residents and businesses. Metro Vancouver meters and bills each member for water consumed.

Working With the Community

Metro Vancouver is committed to working closely with the community to ensure concerns and interests are considered during this project. Local residents and businesses will receive notification through door hangers, newsletters, email, and signage.

We have a dedicated community liaison assigned to this project to answer questions and listen to concerns throughout the project.
