Updated Procedure 330 – Student Extended Leaves of Absence (*Exceeding One Week*)

- Families planning to be away during the school year for an extended period exceeding one week, between October 1 and June 30, must complete and submit an [Extended Leave of Absence Form AP330-B](#) to the school principal prior to the start of the absences.
- For absences of more than one week and less than four weeks (20 instructional days), a place in the student's current school will be held.
- For absences of more than four weeks (more than 20 instructional days), the student may be withdrawn from the school register and would have to re-register through Central Registration upon return. Every effort would be made to place the student in their catchment school; however, placement will be dependent on available space. If there is no space at the catchment school, the student would be placed at the next closest school with space.
