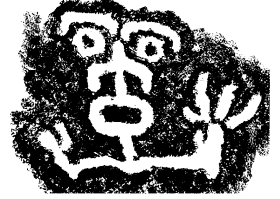

15. REMARKS

Golder Associates Ltd. was retained by School District No. 40 (New Westminster) to undertake historical research regarding the property currently occupied by the New Westminster Secondary School. The New Westminster Public Cemetery (also known as the Douglas Road Cemetery), in active use for such purposes from 1861 to approximately 1920, was situated on a portion of this property within DL 2055 and DL 5678.

It is our understanding that DL 2055 will be subdivided into Parcels A, B, and C. Site NWPC-T1 comprises DL 2055, Parcel C (34,515.3 m²), the northwest corner of DL 5678 (5,629.6 m²), the southwest portion of DL 2055 adjacent to Eighth Street (2,263.8 m²) which is within the existing road right-of-way, and the northwest portion of DL 2055 adjacent to Tenth Avenue (518.2 m²) which is also within the existing road right-of-way.

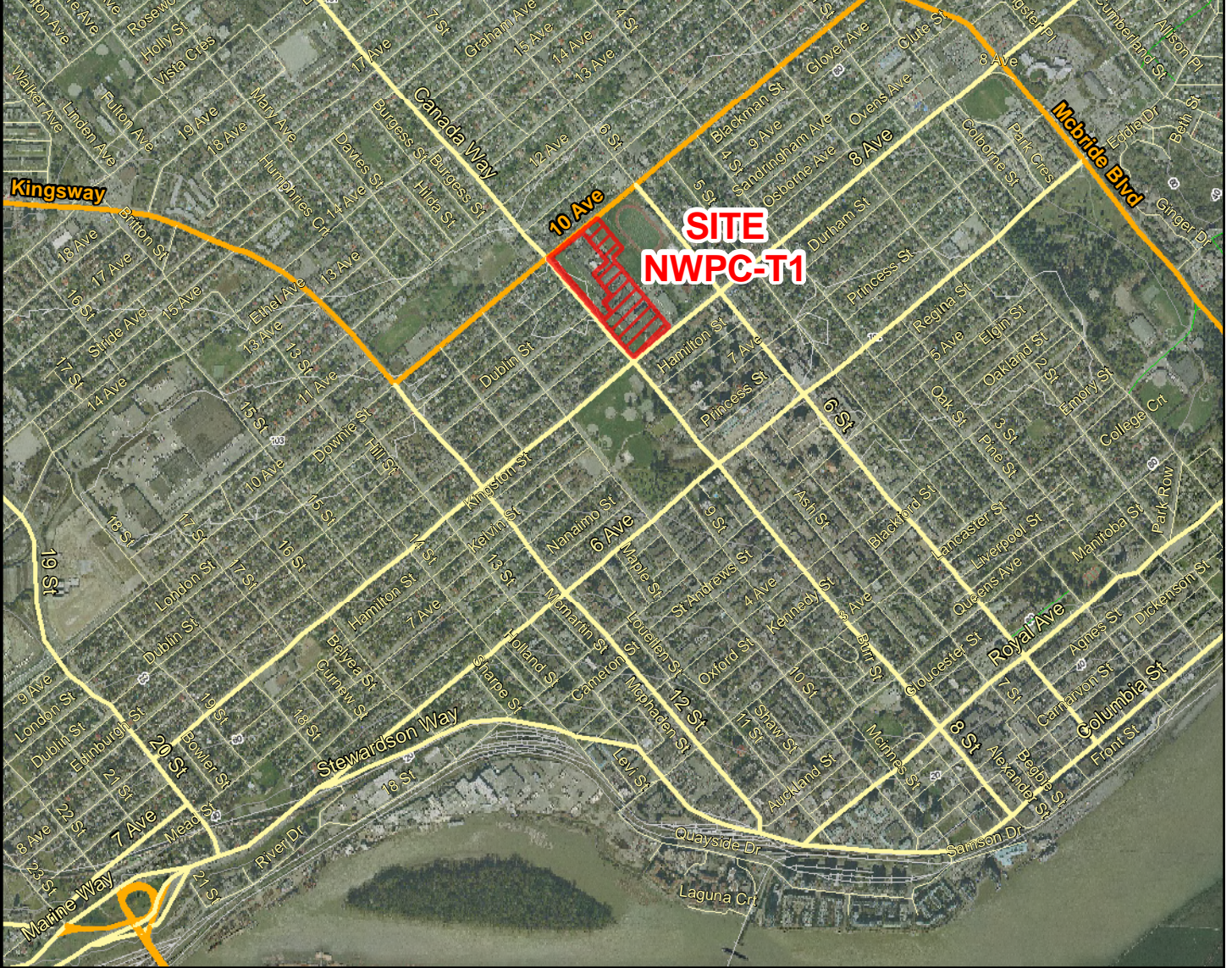
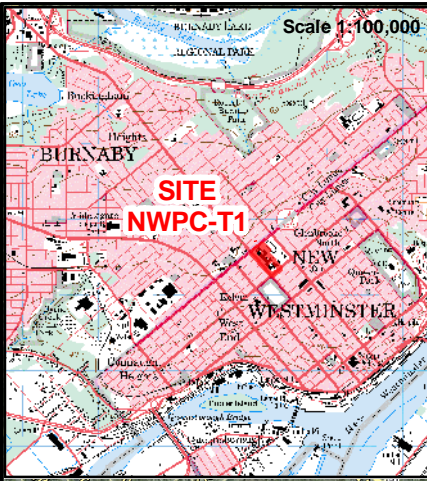
The portions of the existing road rights-of-way on Eighth Street and Tenth Avenue are currently part of DL 2055 and are owned by School District No. 40. It is our understanding that these road rights-of-way and the associated sidewalks will become City of New Westminster land. These portions of road rights-of-way are part of Site NWPC-T1. Their specific dimensions are provided above and are indicated on Figure 3.

Parcels A and B, DL 2055 (totalling 22,796 m²) will be designated as a cemetery under the *Cemetery, Interment and Funeral Services Act* (SBC 2004, Chapter 35). Parcels A and B are not part of this Site inventory record.

Based on archival records consulted, the southern portion of Parcel C may have been used for burials as early as 1875. Between 1892 and 1909, this location was used for burials by the Chinese Community. Archival documents indicate that other groups and individuals used the central portion of Parcel C for burial, however, records are not clear as to specific locations or number of burials in this area. It is known, however, that in 1907 the City of New Westminster's Sanitary Inspector declared the central portion of Parcel C full.

In 1909, two acres adjacent to Tenth Avenue were used for burials by the Chinese Community. This area continued to be used for burials until 1914, with use possibly continuing until 1920. These two acres represent the northwest extent of Site NWPC-T1 in DL 2055, Parcel C and in the adjacent DL 5678.

There is no evidence to suggest that an organized, formal program of removal and/or relocation of human remains was implemented following official closure of the cemetery grounds in 1917. This conclusion applies to both the area that will be designated as a cemetery (Parcels A and B, DL 2055) and the areas beyond Parcels A and B (*i.e.*, Site NWPC-T1). However, within Site NWPC-T1 there is evidence to indicate that the New Westminster Chinese-Canadian community practiced the well-documented cultural tradition of exhuming and returning remains to their village of origin in China. Since it cannot be confirmed that all remains within Site NWPC-T1, whether Chinese or non-Chinese in origin, have been removed and/or relocated, this area is being recorded as Site NWPC-T1 under the *Heritage Conservation Act*.

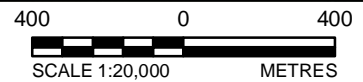

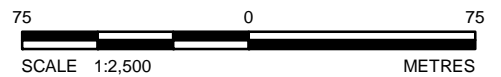
