



REGISTRATION INFORMATION FOR EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS FOR THE 2019 - 2020 SCHOOLYEAR

NEW STUDENTS FOR 2019-2020

All new students can register at their catchment school between 9:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m., Monday to Friday. Information regarding the school registration process, along with a downloadable registration form and a checklist of required documentation, is available on the District website at <http://newwestschools.ca/> (Registration).

KINDERGARTEN

Children who were born in **2014** are eligible to begin school in September 2019. Kindergarten registration for the 2019-2020 school year begins on Monday, January 14, 2019 at your catchment elementary school. Registrations received after Friday, March 15, 2019 will be accommodated at the student's catchment school as space allows.

IN-CATCHMENT

Registrations for the 2019-2020 school year will be accepted at your catchment school, starting Monday, January 14, 2019, for all students new to New Westminister. Students will be accommodated at their catchment school provided they have registered by 2:30 p.m. on Friday, March 15, 2019. Registrations received after March 15, 2019 will be accommodated at the student's catchment school as space allows.

OUT-OF-CATCHMENT AND IN-DISTRICT

Out-of-catchment and in-district students must first register at their catchment school and then complete an Out-of-Catchment form at their catchment school from Monday, January 14, 2019 to Friday, February 15, 2019. Note: Admission decisions may not be finalized before 3:00 p.m. on Friday, June 7, 2019.

OUT-OF-DISTRICT

Out-of-district students apply for admission by completing an Out-of-District form at their preferred school from Monday, January 14, 2019 to Friday, February 15, 2019. However, admission decisions may not be made before 3:00 p.m., Friday, June 7, 2019.

NEW WESTMINSTER SECONDARY SCHOOL (NWSS)

Registration for students not currently enrolled in a New Westminister School begins Monday, January 14, 2019. Applications for out-of-district students are subject to available space and resources.
