Who can attend the Adult Learning Center?

Anyone 18 and over can attend.

How does the program work?

When you come in for registration, you will be given an assessment test. Afterwards, an individual appointment will be made to go over your test results and one of our instructors will suggest an education plan for you. You will be on your way to a successful education in no time!

What are my learning options?

You will have the option to choose between setting your own schedule with self-paced learning or scheduled classroom lessons. Please visit our website for a list of classes offered.

How much does it cost to attend?

If you have not graduated from high school, there is NO TUITION FEE for the courses. Effective September 1st, 2017, the majority of our courses are now funded by the Ministry of Education, making them free of charge to you, even if you have already graduated.

If you are an International student, the international student fee is \$1175.00 per course.
