

SNOW REMOVAL

Background

The District recognizes its responsibility to maintain a safe environment on its schools' grounds. In recognition of that responsibility and recognizing the City of New Westminister's Traffic Bylaw related to snow removal, the District has established procedures for snow removal on sidewalks around schools.

Procedures

1. When there is a significant snowfall (five centimeters or more of snow accumulation), the District will assign staff and contract with a company to commence snow removal to make every reasonable effort to comply with the City Bylaw, which requires removal of snow and ice from sidewalks not later than 10:00 a.m. on the day after the snow or ice was deposited thereon.
2. First priority for District staff will be removing snow to enable safe access to and egress from school buildings.
3. Second priority will be removing snow from sidewalks adjacent to school property.
