STUDENT TECHNOLOGY USER AGREEMENT GRADE 9-12

New Westminster school district provides students with access to a wide variety of digital resources to support learning. Students use technology to conduct research, create digital content, communicate, collaborate, and share ideas. Using technology tools requires students to be responsible digital citizens. Digital citizens look after themselves, others, and property.

When using technology, I will follow these digital citizenship guidelines:

Looking After Yourself and Others

- I use District technology only for educational purposes only.
- I respect myself and others when interacting online by being kind and considerate.
- I do not use abusive, vulgar, profane, obscene, harassing, or other inappropriate language.
- I respect others' privacy by not sharing their personal and private information online.
- I seek permission before posting stories, pictures, or videos involving other people.
- I do not visit sites that are degrading, pornographic, racist, or inappropriate; nor share, store, or duplicate their content. I immediately report accidental access to such material to a staff member.
- I report any online situation that makes me feel unsafe or uncomfortable to a trusted adult.
- I say no to cyberbullying and when I encounter it, I STOP and leave the website, BLOCK communication
 with the cyberbully, TELL a trusted adult immediately.
- I do not share known false or defamatory information about a person or organization.
- I do not attempt to access unauthorized data, servers, or external services.

Looking After Property

- I protect myself by keeping my devices secure and by using high privacy settings.
- I use strong passwords and never share them.
- I do not attempt to impersonate or use someone else's account or identity online.
- I request permission to use or install software and media. Such software and material must be legally purchased, licensed, and registered.
- I follow copyrights laws, act with integrity and do not plagiarize.
- I care for District technology. I do not attempt to vandalize district or external technology and systems, including malicious attempts to destroy data of another user via viruses or other means.

Possible Consequences of Unacceptable Student Use of District Technology

- Loss of district technology privileges.
- Disciplinary action through the school or District code of conduct.
- Financial liability for damaged equipment.

By signing this agreement, I commit to act in a manner that is respectful to myself and others, and to act appropriately, in a moral and ethical manner when using district digital technology. I agree to comply with the principles of digital citizenship outlined in this agreement and accept that failing to follow these quidelines will have consequences.
