2 days a week drop in attendance at each StrongStart location.

We believe all StrongStart families in our community deserve equal and fair opportunities for their children to learn and grow. This is why when we were approached in December with a request for increased attendance at each location, we reviewed our attendance data and we spoke to our educators, school principals, and neighbouring districts for insight on how we can serve your needs. After exploring different ways to streamline our program, we concluded that maintaining our current attendance policies remains the best way for us to serve all our families in an equitable way. Strong Start is a free drop-in service that we provide to our entire New West community, and we want to ensure that families can flexibly attend at all of three of our sites up to 5 times a week if they wish, with the maximum of 2 days at each site. This allows all families many opportunities to engage in different Strong Starts and get to know different families and educators.

By maintaining a 2 day a week per site drop in policy, we can ensure that we rarely have to turn any families away and if new parents move to our community there will be space to allow them to join our drop in sites. There are many amazing and unique learning opportunities offered at each site that will expose your children to a variety of play based learning experiences. Given the small geographical size of New Westminster, families have an opportunity to experience all three sites and attend up to 5 times a week if they wish.
