Play is essential for children's well-being and learning. Whether they're building with blocks, engaging in pretend play, or enjoying a favorite game, your involvement enriches these moments. Make it a daily habit to read together with your child—reading not only cultivates a love for books, but it also strengthens language skills and sparks imagination. Talk about the stories, ask questions, and let your child's curiosity guide the conversation.

We also encourage spending time outdoors. Whether it's taking a walk in the park, visiting a local garden, or playing in your backyard, these experiences foster a sense of wonder and help children connect with the world around them. At StrongStart, we will be heading outdoors every day, please dress for the weather.

educators create play invitations—ranging from art and dramatic play to block-building, science, and books— and invite children to join in stories and group activities. These opportunities support their natural curiosity and growth

We are using an open snack model. In the program, children are

immersed in play. When they are hungry, simply take their snack box and sit at the snack table. Most children invite another friend to join them. By providing opportunities for children to eat when they are hungry, we help them recognize and respond to their body's natural hunger cues. Learning to listen to their bodies is a key step in fostering a lifelong, positive relationship with food.
